We will ride the Metro Blue Line Train. BRING \$6.00 FOR ROUND TRIP FARE !!!

The train leaves the Willow Station and travels to downtown, where we change trains to the Red Line and disembark at historic Union Station. From there we will travel to the Chinese Museum and Pico square with Firehouse #1. After these we will tour Olvera Street, the ORIGINAL site of Los Angeles and tour the Avila Adobe Museum. From here we'll quickly walk through China Town, thence to the L.A. City Hall, the Bradbury Building and finally Grand Central Market for lunch. There are countless specialty food stalls selling all kinds of prepared food. Recommended to buy and try; otherwise enjoy the sack lunch brought along.

From Grand Central Market we'll ***RIDE! Angles Flight*** shortest-in-the-world funicular railroad and then the NEW NEW NEW ELI BROAD MUSEUM, thence to the Kodak Theater along with the Dorothy Chandler Music Center. After this we'll tour the new Catholic Cathedral and art gallery. By this time we will all be ready to hike back to the train station, stopping at famous Phillippe's French Dip restaurant, where the roast beef french dip sandwich was invented 100 years ago. After a french dip and pickled egg, we'll board the train back to Long Beach and then home.

WOW! What a fun-packed day. All the family is welcome, family members must be able to walk the approximately five miles total throughout the day.

Directions to Blue Line: We will depart from the Long Beach Blue Line Train Station at Willow and Long Beach Boulevard. From Redeemer take Edinger west to Bolsa Chica North (right); Bolsa Chica to 405 Freeway North towards Long Beach, 405 Freeway to Long Beach Boulevard exit south (left); Long Beach Boulevard to Willow Street west (right) into large 5 story parking structure FREE PARKING. Buy a round trip ticket for best pricing. Keep ticket with you at all times. No eating or gum on the Train. Parking lot and Trains are security patrolled by LA County Sheriffs.
